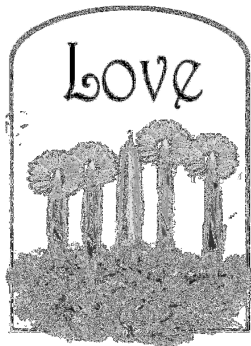


Additional Announcements



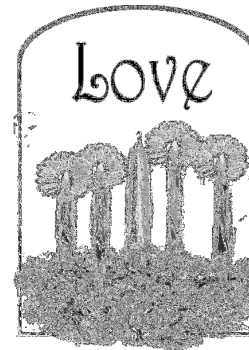
