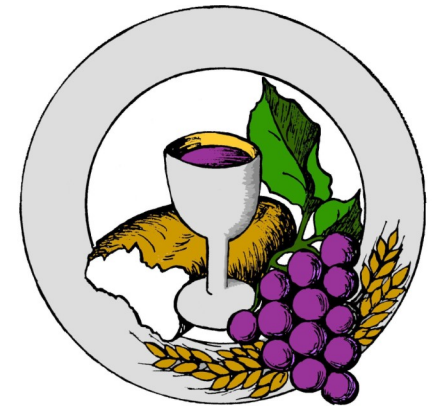

Class Themes

Each session of this class will focus on a particular theme:

- **Belonging**— We are the family of God, welcomed through baptism.
- **Celebrating**— The church family celebrates in worship and in a special part of worship, the Lord's Supper.
- **Remembering**— In the Lord's Supper we remember the life, death and resurrection of Jesus, and find Him present with us.
- **Thanksgiving**— The Lord's Supper is a time for giving thanks, especially for the gift of Christ.
