3. 100 (25 oz.) plastic bottle of a liquid disinfectant dish soap

17 (5-gallon) re-sealable buckets with lids, plus a \$3.00 processing fee per bucket, can either be added to your pledge or be a separate individual pledge. The buckets cost around \$6.00 each at Lowe's or Home Depot.
